Petitioners are represented by two attorneys from different firms. It is unclear which attorney represents which petitioner. Lovlien, the attorney for one of the petitioners, moved to dismiss the case.¹ The other petitioner's other attorney, Thorne, indicated on two occasions that he would send a letter concurring in the motion to dismiss. Thorne has not sent any letters to the Board. In any event, the time for filing the petition for review has passed.
