**NATURE OF THE DECISION**

Petitioners appeal an August 26, 2006 memorandum from the city manager to the city council.

**MOTION TO DISMISS**

The city moves to dismiss this appeal as moot, noting that on December 10, 2007, the city manager issued a new memorandum that explicitly revokes the August 26, 2006 memorandum that is challenged in this appeal. Petitioners have filed no response to the motion.

The city attaches the December 10, 2007 memorandum to its motion. As the city notes, it explicitly revokes the August 26, 2006 memorandum in its entirety. Accordingly, we agree with the city that our review of petitioner’s challenges to the August 26, 2006 memorandum would have no practical effect, and therefore this appeal should be dismissed as moot.

This appeal is dismissed.
