On July 17, 2014, petitioner filed a Notice of Intent to appeal that did not
comply with the requirements of OAR 661-010-0015 and that was not
accompanied by the required filing fee and deposit for costs. On the same date
the Board issued an order requiring petitioner to (1) file an amended NITA that
complies with the requirements of OAR 661-010-0015 and (2) pay the required
\$200 filing fee and \$200 deposit for costs, not later than July 24, 2014.

On July 23, 2014, petitioner filed a document entitled "Cancellation of Notice of Intent to Appeal, with memo." That document does not comply with the requirements of OAR 661-010-0015 and it was not accompanied by a filing fee and deposit for costs. Accordingly, pursuant to OAR 661-010-0015(1)(c), the appeal is dismissed.
