Opinion by Holstun.

Pursuant to ORS 197.830(13)(b) and OAR 661-010-0021, respondent withdrew the decisions challenged in these appeals for reconsideration on September 14, 2017. On October 2, 2017, the Board received the county's decision on reconsideration. Pursuant to OAR 661-010-0021(5)(1), petitioner had until October 23, 2017 to either refile its original notice of intent to appeal in this matter, or file an amended notice of intent to appeal.
