## Opinion by Bassham.

## NATURE OF THE DECISION

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- In LUBA No. 2017-018, petitioners appeal a February 7, 2017 land use
- 4 compatibility statement (LUCS) concluding that temporary storage of water in
- 5 two reservoirs to support various land uses is not regulated by the county's land
- 6 use ordinance (hereafter, the 2017 Limited License LUCS). In LUBA No.
- 7 2017-019, petitioners appeal a February 17, 2017 county decision concluding
- 8 that there is no right of local appeal for the 2017 Limited License LUCS.

## MOTION TO DISMISS

- The county and intervenor-respondent KC Development Group, LLC
- 11 (KCDG) move to dismiss these appeals as moot. Petitioners oppose the
- 12 motion. The arguments on both sides are identical to the arguments raised in
- 13 the companion consolidated appeals involving a different LUCS decision
- 14 regarding the same subject property. In a final opinion and order issued this
- date, we agreed with respondents that the companion appeals are now moot,
- 16 and dismissed those appeals. Bishop v. Deschutes County, \_\_ Or LUBA \_\_
- 17 (LUBA Nos. 2017-002/003, January 5 2018). For the same reasons, we
- 18 conclude that LUBA Nos. 2017-018 and LUBA No. 2017-019 are also moot,
- 19 and must be dismissed.
- 20 LUBA No. 2017-018 and LUBA No. 2017-019 are dismissed.
