2 On July 23, 2019, the Board received a notice of intent to appeal that was  
3 not accompanied by the filing fee and deposit for costs required by OAR 661-  
4 010-0015(4), and that did not comply with OAR 661-010-0015 in other respects.  
5 Our July 24, 2019 order required petitioner to (1) file an amended notice of intent  
6 to appeal that complies with OAR 661-010-0015, and (2) remit payment of the  
7 filing fee and deposit for costs for the notice of intent to appeal. The order notified  
8 petitioner that pursuant to OAR 661-010-0015(1)(c) if the filing fee and deposit  
9 for costs and amended notice of intent to appeal were not filed by August 2, 2019,  
10 the Board would dismiss the appeal.

11 The Board has not received the required filing fee and deposit for costs or  
12 an amended notice of intent to appeal. Accordingly, pursuant to OAR 661-010-  
13 0015(1)(c), this appeal is dismissed.
