On February 28, 2019, the county withdrew for reconsideration the decision challenged in this appeal pursuant to ORS 197.830(13)(b) and OAR 661-010-0021. On September 5, 2019, the Board received the county's decision on reconsideration, repealing the original decision challenged in this appeal. Petitioners had until September 26, 2019 to file an amended notice of intent to appeal. OAR 661-010-0021(5)(a). OAR 661-010-0021(5)(e) provides "[i]f no amended notice of intent to appeal is filed or no original notice of intent to appeal is refiled, as provided in [OAR 661-010-0021(5)(a) and (b)], the appeal will be dismissed."
