Opinion by Ryan.

On January 29, 2020, the Board received a notice of intent to appeal that did not comply with OAR 661-010-0015 in several respects. In a February 4, 2020 order, the Board ordered petitioners to file with the Board and serve on all parties required to be served an amended notice of intent to appeal that complies with OAR 661-010-0015. The order notified petitioners that if an amended notice of intent to appeal was not filed and served by February 11, 2020, the Board would dismiss the appeal.

In a subsequent February 14, 2020 order, the Board again ordered petitioners to file with the Board and serve on all parties required to be served an amended notice of intent to appeal that complies with OAR 661-010-0015. The order notified petitioners that if an amended notice of intent to appeal was not filed and served by February 24, 2020, the Board would dismiss the appeal.

The Board has not received an amended notice of intent to appeal. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed.
