NATURE OF THE DECISION

- 3 Petitioner appeals a city ordinance amending the enforcement provisions
- 4 of the John Day Development Code.

MOTION TO DISMISS

- 6 On June 2, 2020, petitioner filed the notice of intent to appeal. On June 19,
- 7 2020, the city withdrew the ordinance for reconsideration pursuant to ORS
- 8 197.830(13)(b). The city now moves to dismiss this appeal, noting that the city
- 9 decided not to adopt the ordinance on reconsideration. The decision not to adopt
- 10 the ordinance is attached to the city's motion.
- Petitioner has not responded to the city's motion to dismiss. Because
- 12 LUBA's review of the ordinance would have no practical effect, the present
- appeal is moot. Jacobsen v. City of Winston, 61 Or LUBA 465, 466 (2010).
- 14 Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed.
