- The Board received the city's record transmittal on September 10, 2020.
- 3 On September 30, 2020, petitioners filed a stipulated motion to suspend the
- 4 briefing schedule pursuant to OAR 661-010-0067(2). That stipulated motion
- 5 provided that any party may move to reinstate the appeal and that, upon
- 6 reinstatement, petitioner would have seven days to submit the petition for review.
- 7 See OAR 661-010-0067(2) (providing that the deadline for filing the petition for
- 8 review may be extended with the written consent of all parties). On October 5,
- 9 2020, the Board issued an order suspending this appeal pursuant to the parties'
- 10 stipulated motion.
- On January 4, 2021, intervenor filed a motion to reactivate the appeal. On
- 12 January 8, 2021, the Board issued an order reinstating the appeal and setting a
- briefing schedule, by which the petition for review was due to be filed on January
- 14 15, 2021. Petitioners did not file a petition for review. Failure to file a petition
- 15 for review within the time required by OAR 661-010-0030(1) or any extensions
- of that time under OAR 661-010-0067(2) shall result in dismissal of the appeal.
