2 In this consolidated proceeding, petitioner appeals four enforcement orders
3 issued by a county hearings officer concerning unpermitted structures on
4 petitioner's property.

5 On November 7, 2024, petitioner filed a petition for review. OAR 661-
6 010-0030(3) provides:

“If the Board determines that the petition for review fails to conform with the requirements of section (2) of this rule, it shall notify the author, and a brief conforming with the requirements of section (2) shall be filed within three (3) days of notification by the Board. The Board may refuse to consider a brief that does not substantially conform to the requirements of this rule.”

13 On November 19, 2024, we issued an order explaining that the petition for
14 review did not comply with OAR 661-010-0030 subsection (2) and subsection
15 (4) in several respects and instructing petitioner to file an amended petition for
16 review that complies with our rules no later than December 3, 2024. Petitioner
17 did not file an amended petition for review. The petition for review that petitioner
18 did file does not substantially conform to the requirements of OAR 661-010-
19 0030. Accordingly, we refuse to consider it.

20 These appeals are dismissed.
