RE: CPT Codes and Scope of Practice

MEMORANDUM

The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners (OBCE), the agency that regulates, licenses, and determines scope of practice for Oregon licensed Doctors of Chiropractic (DCs) and Certified Chiropractic Assistants (CAs), held a special board meeting on November 13, 2025, to hear public comment regarding recent policy updates, practices, and apparent confusion of certain health insurance carriers regarding which services are considered covered under a chiropractic license and chiropractic assistant certificate. Essentially, whether certain CPT codes associated with practice modalities are within the scope of practice for these licensed professionals.

The Board voted to issue this guidance for the purpose of clarification around scope of practice.

ORS 684.010 to 684.990 govern the practice of chiropractic in Oregon. ORS 684.010(2) defines "Chiropractic", ORS 684.010(5) defines minor surgery, and ORS 684.155(1)(c) to (d) authorize the Board to establish standards for chiropractic assistants and the use of ancillary personnel. As such, the following modalities are within the scope of practice of DCs and CAs:

97010 - hot or cold pack therapy

97012 - mechanical traction

97014/G0283 - electrical stimulation (unattended)

97018 - paraffin bath therapy

97022 - whirlpool therapy

97024 - diathermy

97026 - infrared therapy

97032 - electrical stimulation (attended)

97035 - ultrasound

97110 - therapeutic exercise

97112 - neuromuscular re-education

97116 - gait training

97124 - massage therapy

97140 - manual therapy

97530 - therapeutic activities

97535 - self-care/home management training

97760 - orthotic management and training, initial encounter

97762 - orthotic checkout

97763 - orthotic management, subsequent encounters

9940x - preventive medicine counseling including but not limited to general healthy habits, diet, smoking, nursing/lactation, safe sex practices, vaccine information and counseling

99401 - 15 mins

99402 - 30 mins

99403 - 45 mins

99404 - 60 mins

The Board does not regulate CPT codes. These are provided for ease of reference.
