Adams, Barbara – Unlicensed

Engaged in unlicensed practice, unethical advertising of services including illegal use of the title, “Licensed Professional Counselor”.

Discipline: Payment of civil penalty and disciplinary costs.

04/18/2018

Adams, Meredith – C4338

Respondent failed to disclose an arrest on application. She submitted a deceptive narrative to the Board and provided a misleading explanation when questioned by the Board’s investigators.

Discipline: Reprimand, practice under supervision, and payment of civil penalty and disciplinary costs.

10/12/2012

Alexander, Christa (Bailey) – Licensed: C3369

Licensee provided counseling services to client after her objectivity and effectiveness became impaired; failed to safeguard client confidences.

Discipline: 300 hours of additional supervised intern hours, mental health evaluation, and payment of disciplinary costs.

12/16/2013

Armstrong, Todd – Licensed: C1439

Licensee failed to recognize professional responsibility; failed to avoid client harm by failure to immediately report suspected child abuse; failed to provide counseling records; failed to refer client when personal situation was interfering with ability to provide professional services.

Discipline: Supervision for 6 months, additional ethics course, child abuse reporting requirements course, and payment of disciplinary process costs.

Baker, Samuel C. – C1833

Licensee provided client information in a request for referral on social media without obtaining client consent.

Discipline: Reprimand, additional continuing education and payment of disciplinary costs.

03/08/2013

Baldwin, Heidi – LPC Intern R1853: Revoked

Respondent engaged in an inappropriate dual and sexual relationship with a client.

Discipline: Internship revoked; permanently prohibited from seeking licensure or internship or using any like title.

10/13/2017

Bartholomew, Stacey – C3291: License Surrendered

Engaged in an inappropriate dual and sexual relationship with a client.

Discipline: Surrender of license, payment of disciplinary costs.

12/02/2016

Becker, Alvin – LPC Intern Application Denied

Respondent submitted an application that was deceptive to the Board. Respondent misrepresented an arrest that occurred in 2010. The Board investigation revealed respondent was arrested and convicted of ORS 163.575.

Discipline: Application is denied and payment of disciplinary costs.

07/16/2014

Becsei, Aniko – Licensed: C1402

Licensee dispensed prescription medication; practiced outside boundaries of competence.

Discipline: Written reprimand.

12/02/2016

Bertoli, Jeanne – Unlicensed

Individual engaged in illegal unlicensed practice of professional counseling via Skype.

Discipline: \$2,500 civil penalty and payment of disciplinary costs.

04/02/2010

Bird, David –T0375: Revoked

Engaged in dual relationships with multiple clients; used the counseling relationship to further sexual interests; engaged in or solicited a sexual relationship with client; used the counseling relationship to further his personal and financial interests; negligence; failed to conform to standards of conduct; failed to recognize professional responsibility and caused harm to clients; breach of confidentiality.

Discipline: License revoked; forever prohibited from holding a LPC or LMFT license in Oregon; payment of disciplinary costs.

07/16/2014

Blaszak, Barbara – C0083 and T0038: Surrendered

Failed to provide the mother of two minor children with a copy of the children's counseling records because she had lost them.

Discipline: Licensee surrenders both Oregon LPC and LMFT licenses, and prohibited from using the title, purporting to be, or practicing as a LPC or LMFT or using any other title that includes those words in the state of Oregon.

06/18/2008

Bliss, Vivien – Licensed: C1117

Licensee exceeded the scope of her license by reviewing and testifying in court regarding test scores for program participants.

Discipline: Written reprimand, civil penalty and payment of disciplinary costs.

04/29/2013

Boudinot, Douglas - Unlicensed

Individual engaged in illegal unlicensed practice.

Discipline: Civil penalty of \$5,000, to be suspended under the condition the Respondent abides by Stipulated Final order, however must pay of disciplinary costs.

12/07/2018

Boudinot, Douglas - Unlicensed

Engaged in unlicensed practice in violation of his previous Stipulated Order.

Discipline: \$5000.00 civil penalty.

08/13/2010

Bourcy, Lyle – Renewal Denied; C2200

Disciplinary action by Idaho State Board found Licensee engaged in an inappropriate sexual affair with a Client's mother. Idaho Board found Licensee's conduct violated Idaho laws and rules; Licensee surrendered Idaho License.

Discipline: Renewal of his Oregon license is hereby denied and payment of disciplinary costs.

06/06/2014

Boyce, Mary J – Licensed: C3694

As an Intern, failed to safeguard confidential client files; left records unattended in her vehicle, then failed to immediately take action to locate records.

Discipline: Supervision for six months, one session per month, with report to Board.

07/17/2012

Bramlette, Susan – Licensed: T0456

Provided therapy to client without written consent to treat and disclosed confidential information without consent while practicing in Washington State.

Discipline: Supervision for two years, 18 additional hours of continuing education, payment of disciplinary costs.

03/05/09

Bramlette, Susan – Licensed: T0456

Arizona Board action which indicates violation of Arizona law.

Discipline: Complete one graduate-level ethics course with a grade of "B" or higher and one year of supervision.

08/13/2010

Brunning, Vincent – Previously licensed: C186

Failed to recognize professional responsibility and caused harm to clients and coworkers; failed to conform to standards of conduct; treated clients and coworkers in a discourteous and disrespectful manner.

Discipline: Written reprimand; supervision for one year, six hours training in suicide assessment and intervention, three hours training in social and cultural competency and diversity, and payment of disciplinary costs.

06/05/2018

Bruton, Wendy – C2439: License Surrendered

Entered into a multiple relationship with her interns. Failed to provide appropriate supervision to interns. Failed to inform the Board in a timely manner when business location was moved.

Discipline: Surrender of license, payment of civil penalty and disciplinary costs.

10/7/2016

Buchanan, Danette – Licensed: C3577

Client of Respondent disclosed that she had a felony conviction and had been incarcerated. Respondent subsequently submitted a public records request to Oregon State Police seeking a copy of client's criminal offender information. Client incurred harm. Respondent failed to take care to do no harm to client.

Discipline: Written reprimand, and payment of disciplinary costs.

12/01/2017

Buck, Andrew W. – Registration Revoked

Breached client confidentiality. Failed to disclose termination from previous employment. Repeatedly counseled about lack of professional demeanor and subsequently terminated from employment.

Discipline: Revocation of registration, payment of disciplinary costs.

12/01/2017

Bullock, Mark – C4410: License Surrendered

Licensee failed to disclose that he had been under investigation by a former employer when he submitted an application for licensure by reciprocity. The Board concluded Licensee made numerous repeated sexual advances toward female employees in the workplace.

Discipline: Surrender of license, payment of disciplinary costs.

08/14/2018

Bush, Alison L. – Intern: R3710

Registrant's employment record noted excessive absences due to health related issues that interfered with her ability to practice. Registrant was cited for driving under the influence of an intoxicant and ordered into diversion.

Discipline: Registrant was reprimanded and ordered to pay disciplinary process costs.

06/7/2016

Chapman, Terri – Licensed: C1386

Respondent was impaired and unable to safely practice; failed to self-report extensive impairment history.

Discipline: Immediately withdraw from practice, complete treatment and fitness for duty evaluation.

10/14/2011

Clark, James R – Licensed: C1913

Failed to refer clients to other treatment resources when warranted and provided services to clients beyond his area of practice.

Discipline: 6 months of supervision and report to the Board, a written reprimand and payment of disciplinary costs.

12/10/2010

Coats, Diana Lynn – Licensed: C2554

Provided supervisor with prescription medication; failed to report supervisor to health licensing board and agency management in a timely manner.

Discipline: Additional intern supervision with report, payment of disciplinary costs.

09/04/2014

Collier, Anna N – Licensed, C3000

In the course of her employment by the Health Professional Service Program, Licensee compromised the confidentiality of clients when sending out a group email.

Discipline: Written Letter of Reprimand, ethics course, payment of disciplinary costs.

12/13/2013

Cook, Jeffrey – Licensed: C2353

Inappropriate and improper communications with client over a period of three years, in person and later by telephone, violated confidentiality of client in communications with client's husband, failed to terminate counseling relationship despite admission that he was unable to help client.

Discipline: Supervision for six months with report, ethics course, payment of disciplinary costs.

06/06/2014

Creason, Traci L. – Licensed: C2926

Licensee confided personal romantic feelings for an inmate client and opened a PO Box so the inmate could write to her, also failed to transfer client to another counselor.

Discipline: One year supervision, with report, Board-approved ethics course on dual relationships, payment of disciplinary costs.

08/04/2008

Crippen, John – Licensed: T0692

Failed to respect the rights of his client by allowing his religious perspectives and views to affect the counseling relationship.

Discipline: Written reprimand, submit revised Professional Disclosure Statement.

02/05/2016

Cudmore, Rachel – Licensed: C2027

Licensee's conduct reflects that she failed to consider impact of her personal conduct in regard to Client A, and how her conduct could be harmful and exploitive in regard to both Client A and B.

Discipline: Licensee is reprimanded, 1 year of supervision, payment of disciplinary costs.

Davis, Christina L. – Licensed: R5038

Accessed confidential client file for personal reasons.

Discipline: Reprimand, complete an ethics course, supervision until granted unrestricted license, payment of disciplinary costs.

11/01/2012

Davis, Jeffrey S. – LPC Application Denied

Engaged in a sexual relationship with former client while licensed in the State of New Mexico. NM Board imposed discipline, as Respondent did not contest the allegations.

Discipline: License application denied, payment of disciplinary costs.

07/12/2012

Delaney, James – Licensed: T0899

Failed to report suspected child abuse after being told by second party first and then verified by victim.

Discipline: Ethics class, supervision, disciplinary costs.

09/22/2009

Dody, Nadine – Licensed: C1979

Engaged in a dual relationship with client; failed to advance client's best interests; failed to act in accordance with highest standards of professional integrity and competence.

Discipline: Written reprimand; supervision for one year; payment of disciplinary costs; six hours ethics training; ACCBO accredited A&D counseling theories training.

05/16/2014

Donaldson, Steven M. – Licensed: C0975

Licensee exchanged counseling services for personal work with a long-term client. Licensee made a former client a full partner at a non-counseling business 14 months after their professional relationship ended, and hired another former client to perform services to the business.

Discipline: Supervision for 12 months, with report to the Board; 60 hours of ethics coursework; one year of personal therapy with a Board-approved LPC; payment of disciplinary costs.

04/01/2016

Doyle, Beth A. – Licensed: C1630

Licensee failed to provide OYA with timely documentation for her clients. Licensee failed to maintain adequate client records.

Discipline: Supervision for up to 12 months with report to the Board; payment of disciplinary costs.

08/03/2018

Dykes, Sarah Z. – Intern: R4870

Engaged in a dual relationship with client; failed to advance client's best interests; failed to act in accordance with highest standards of professional integrity and competence.

Discipline: Suspension for 6 months, supervision for 12 months, continuing education, payment of disciplinary costs.

03/02/2010

Eaton-Schulman, David – LMFT Application for Licensure Denied

Respondent was convicted of crimes that bring into question competence as a counselor or therapist; attempted to obtain a license by making fraudulent representations to the Board.

Discipline: Application for licensure denied; Payment of disciplinary costs.

01/05/2009

Emery, Sharon – Licensed: T0816

Licensee provided a couple counseling. After the couple separated, Licensee disclosed confidential information in writing to Client B's attorney about Client A without consent.

Discipline: Written reprimand.

08/14/2018

Evans, Nicole – Revoked: R4146

Engaged in a dual relationship with Client A and disclosed confidential information to Client A about other clients without their consent.

Discipline: Registration revoked; Payment of disciplinary process costs.

10/7/2016

Fair, Jason – Revoked: R3181

Respondent was providing counseling services to an adult female. During subsequent counseling sessions respondent began to correspond by text message with client. Texts became personal in nature which resulted in a romantic sexual relationship with client.

Discipline: License/registration is revoked and payment of disciplinary costs.

04/23/2010

Feuille, Frank – Licensed: C1222

Licensee had an extra concert ticket and invited the client to attend with Licensee.

Client interpreted invitation as a request for a date even though Client was

married. Discipline: Ethics training; supervision for 6 months upon return from retirement.

10/05/2018

Finkelman, Robert – C1684, License Surrendered

Licensee made false and misleading statements to the Board's investigators. Licensee engaged in a dual/sexualized relationship with Client A and unreasonably delayed providing a copy of Client A's records to her after her request.

Discipline: Surrender of license, prohibited from re-applying for licensure, and payment of disciplinary costs.

04/03/2009

Finnegan, Kathleen – Licensed: C1100

Provided counseling services to minor without obtaining custodial parent's consent; disclosed confidential information.

Discipline: Written reprimand, 6 sessions of supervision within 1 year with report and cost of disciplinary process.

02/15/2015

Fischer-Grady, Hannah – C1901, License Surrendered

Licensee counseled a client; she exchanged various services with client; violated professional boundaries by encouraging and engaging in non-sexual intimacy; Licensee failed to consult with other professionals regarding the client's condition, failed to properly terminate the relationship.

Discipline: Immediate surrender of license, agreed never to re-apply for licensure as LPC or LMFT; and pay costs of \$2,210.10, paid 2/5/2015.

08/29/2011

Fischer-Grady, Hannah – Licensed: C1901

Licensee entered into a relationship with former client, which furthered own personal interests despite clear risk of exploitation.

Discipline: Amended Final Order in Default: Supervision for six months, fitness for duty evaluation, ethics training and payment of disciplinary costs.

04/07/2017

Fossett, Jr., Nickey R. – T1020

Licensee engaged in an inappropriate dual and sexual relationship with a client.

Discipline: Stayed revocation subject to full compliance of terms of Order, two years under supervision, no social contact with any current or former client within three years after termination of services, completion of 6 hours of boundaries training, continuation of therapy, and payment of disciplinary costs.

12/01/2017

Fossett, Jr., Nickey R. – T1020: License Revoked

Violated terms of a Default Order by engaging in an inappropriate dual and sexual relationship with former client within three years from rendering services.

Discipline: Surrender of license, payment of disciplinary costs.

02/01/2019

Fox, Thomas R. – R3281: Registration Suspended

Did not adequately maintain client records, to include the pre-mature destruction of records, and failed to inform both Board and clients of the destruction of records. Provided services to clients after registration had expired, constituting unlicensed practice.

Discipline: Surrender of registration, required continuing education, payment of disciplinary costs, and Board pre-approval of any future supervision.

Garrett, Carolyn – Licensed: T0814

Licensee failed to obtain informed consent to provide counseling services to two children. Licensee refused to provide records and counseled the children on how to interact with their father in negative terms, Licensee lost objectivity

Discipline: Supervision for 12 months and payment of disciplinary costs.

12/07/2018

Griffiths, Christine – Applicant

Applicant submitted an application that was deceptive to the Board. She misrepresented two arrests and failed to cooperate with the Board's investigator. Applicant also failed to disclose arrests to another state in which she is licensed.

Discipline: Reprimand, payment of civil penalty and disciplinary costs.

Hammond, Mary – C0709: License Revoked

Respondent engaged in a dual relationship and caused client harm by asking her client to co-sign on a Mortgage loan. Respondent also had several clients attend and pay for training at the Respondent's home.

Discipline: License revoked and payment of disciplinary costs.

08/05/2016

Hardie-Williams, Kathy Ann – Licensed: C3332, T0988

Respondent provided couples counseling. During individual sessions Respondent violated confidentiality by disclosing confidential information with the other spouse. Respondent lost objectivity by forming an alliance with other spouse.

Discipline: 6 hours of continuing education on professional boundaries, 6 hours of continuing education on domestic violence, 12 months supervision and payment of disciplinary costs.

10/05/2018

Hayden, David M. – Licensed: LPC Intern, R4462

Registrant entered into a multiple relationship, misrepresented himself to the public, and made fraudulent statements to the Board.

Discipline: Reprimand, boundaries training, removal of "QMHP" from professional representations, and payment of disciplinary process costs.

02/03/2017

Hoersting, Leo W. – LMFT Intern Applicant

Respondent failed to disclose an arrest that occurred 2006. Respondent explained that he had made a mistake despite having submitted nearly an exact copy of his explanation when questioned by another licensing Board. Respondent violated integrity.

Discipline: Respondent was reprimanded, civil penalty imposed and payment of disciplinary costs.

06/05/2015

Hoskins, Adrienne V. – C2050: License Surrendered

Entered into a dual and sexual relationship with a former client within three years of termination of services.

Discipline: Surrender of license, payment of disciplinary costs.

06/05/2015

Houser, Kerrin L. – C2449: License Revoked

Entered into a dual relationship with a client over a period of more than five years, which included boundary violations and breaches of confidentiality. Respondent falsely reported to DHS that the client sexually abused a child more than a year after her interpretation of the event during a session. The report was filed only after an official investigation against Licensee for her conduct concerning her client was opened.

Discipline: License revoked and payment of disciplinary costs.

09/08/2014

Hurley, Kathy – C3271: License Revoked

Licensee began an affair with the husband of a former client less than three years after the client relationship had ended. Licensee had seen the client and husband for three sessions to address marital problems.

Discipline: License revoked and payment of disciplinary costs.

Irvin, Michael - Unlicensed

Engaged in unlicensed practice, unethical advertising of services including illegal use of the title, "Licensed Professional Counselor".

Discipline: Payment of civil penalties and disciplinary costs.

06/05/2015

Isgrigg, Adrienne L. – LPC Intern, Expired, Surrendered

Respondent charged criminally with 71 counts of making a false claim for health care payment, plead guilty and convicted of one count, others dismissed; by her conduct, she failed to act in accordance with the highest standards of professional integrity.

Discipline: Stipulated Final Order, license surrendered immediately, costs < \$250.00.

Jagow, Hanna M. – C2185: License Surrendered

Licensee engaged in improper conduct with female client; inability to provide counseling services due to impairment.

Discipline: Surrender of license, payment of disciplinary costs, unable to submit new application for two years.

08/7/2014

James, Philip R. – Licensed: C1711

Licensee engaged in improper conduct with female client; inability to provide counseling services due to impairment.

Discipline: Voluntary withdrawal from practice.

10/7/2016

Jenkins, Emily A – LPC Intern: R3991

Respondent provided “coaching” services which was found to be professional counseling services. In doing so, Respondent engaged in work that was outside of her scope of practice, and failed to notify or confer with her practice supervisor about this activity.

Discipline: Written reprimand, ethics course, 12 months of additional supervision and payment of disciplinary costs.

02/01/2019

Jenkins, Emily A – LPC Intern R3991: Application Denied

Respondent failed to comply with the terms of her previous Default Order. Respondent misrepresented herself to the Board on her application, and failed to disclose charges against her as well as her change of employment.

Discipline: Application for renewal denied.

09/14/2009

Johnson, Joan - C1366: License Surrendered

Failed to disclose and/or accurately describe a prior criminal conviction; made fraudulent statements to the Board; failed to act in accordance with standards of conduct.

Discipline: Permanent surrender of license; prohibited from reapplying or reinstatement; prohibited from using the title, purporting to be, or practicing as a licensed professional counselor or licensed marriage and family therapist; payment of disciplinary costs.

05/02/2006

Jones, Kenneth H. – License Surrendered

Licensee was found to have been grossly negligent in providing services to client RW, did not promote the client's welfare or best interests, and engaged in sexual harassment or exploitation of client.

Discipline: Stipulation and Final Order, license surrendered immediately, will not apply or register with the Board at any time or for at least ten years.

04/28/2015

Jones, Ronald R – Reciprocal License Application Denied

Respondent is licensed in Idaho; he applied for an LPC license in Oregon by reciprocity, and disclosed a prior disciplinary sanction had been imposed by the Idaho Board: he was suspended for one month, placed on probation for one year, and fined for engaging in boundary violations in 2007 with a female client.

Discipline: Final Order Denying Application, payment of disciplinary costs.

Kauffman, Katherine – C3371

Licensee composed a referral for medical transition based on another QMHP's referral letter when it was deemed insufficient. The referral was composed on behalf of someone with whom she had a personal relationship and was not a client.

Discipline: Reprimand, payment of disciplinary costs.

12/15/2014

Kerlee, Ronald L – C1748: License Revoked

Licensee engaged in manipulative sexual conduct with a young adult male client beginning at the onset of services in the fall of 2012. The client was suffering from depression, low self-esteem and sexuality issues.

Discipline: License Revoked, payment of disciplinary costs.

12/12/2008

King, Richard B. – Surrendered: C0436

Stipulated Order 12/12/2008

Licensee violated rules of the Board, failed to advance the welfare and best interests of his client, and failed to act with the highest standards of professional integrity and competence.

Discipline: Permanent surrender of license; never to seek reinstatement, registration, or apply to practice with this Board; prohibited from using the title, purporting to be, or practicing as a licensed professional counselor or licensed marriage and family therapist in Oregon; reimbursement of partial costs of disciplinary process.

Injunction 9/24/2012

Marion County Circuit Court issued an injunction barring Mr. King from using the title “doctor”, assessing, diagnosing, or treating clients; using the DSM; mental health interviewing, testing, assessing, evaluating, administering or interpreting tests; leading, facilitating or co-facilitating group or individual therapy sessions; rendering supervision, consultation, evaluation or other therapy services; practicing psychology or calling himself a psychologist.

12/06/2013

Kohlenberger, Sarah – Licensed: C2557

Failed to refer client’s child to a different provider, provided therapy to the child, despite treating the parent, and acted negligently by failing to incorporate client’s medical condition into treatment plan.

Discipline: Adopted Washington State’s discipline for licensee; Letter of reprimand; 24 months of supervision and 16 hours of training in classes relating to violations

12/07/2018

Krayer, Susan B. – C1374: License Surrendered

Respondent engaged in a multiple relationships with clients. She caused client harm by loaning her client money and engaging in boundary violations. Respondent also breached confidentiality of other clients and had a conflict of interest as those clients were related to each other.

Discipline: License is permanently surrendered and Licensee may not reapply with the Board; payment of disciplinary costs.

LaMere, Kelly – Application Denied

Applicant failed to disclose her complete record of arrests and did not provide satisfactory evidence that she was not in violation of ORS 675.715 to 675.835 and the rules adopted by the Board.

Discipline: Denial of license, payment of disciplinary costs.

02/10/2012

Larsen, Jeannette – Application Denied

Applicant unable to safely perform the duties of professional counseling because of impairment.

Discipline: Denial of license.

10/2/2015

Lawyer-Hellman, Shirley – LPC: C3381

Licensee performed professional services beyond her field of competence. Licensee disclosed confidential client information without written informed consent. Licensee failed to safeguard client and to take reasonable steps to avoid client harm.

Discipline: 6 Months of supervision, ethics training and payment of disciplinary costs.

06/09/2017

Lohman, Carolyn – Revoked: R3654

Engaged in an inappropriate dual and sexual relationship with a client.

Discipline: Revocation of intern registration, payment of disciplinary costs.

02/02/2018

Lovejoy, Gary – C0562

Provided biased evaluations during marital counseling. Failed to provide referrals when his objectivity was impaired. Breached confidentiality of client when he disclosed client information to her family.

Discipline: Reprimand, continuing education, payment of disciplinary costs.

12/01/2017

Malik, Yasmin – LPC Intern: R2871

Provided inaccurate information on her application when she checked “no” to a question which asked if applicant was ever the subject of a complaint to a professional organization, association, licensing board or agency.

Discipline: Reprimand, payment of civil penalty and disciplinary costs.

02/11/2011

Massena, Robert – Revoked: C1957

Violated confidentiality of client information; engaged in sexual acts during counseling sessions with the wife of a couple to whom he was providing counseling services.

Discipline: Revocation of license; payment of disciplinary costs.

02/08/2013

Mathewson, Clayton – Unlicensed

Violated order with the Board by representing himself as a professional therapist on multiple websites and offering professional counseling services without being licensed.

Discipline: Civil penalty imposed

08/21/2009

Mathewson, Clayton – C0563, License surrendered
