Ratification of licenses issued since previous Board meeting: Motion to ratify new licenses and permits issued since the last Board meeting. A motion was made by Breedlove and seconded by Hopkins to approve the licenses and permits. Voice Vote was unanimous.

The Board discussed and reviewed the public commentary from the public hearing and those submitted within the public comment period and voted unanimously to adopt permanent rules for Cultural Competence and for complying with Governor's Orders during an emergency.

The Board discussed the possibility of changing the expiration date for licensure to occur on the last day of the Birth month rather than the first day of the Birth month and the Board consensus was to not move forward with pursuing that issue due to costs and that the change would not align with all credentialing organizations.

Other business:
