

How do I become an OBMI Board Member?

There are several steps to become an OBMI Board Member that are briefly outlined below. There are more details on the Governor's Website [HERE](#).

1. Look for a vacancy on the OBMI website
2. Determine if your qualifications match the requirements for the vacancy available
3. Complete an Interest form located on the Governor's website
4. Submit your Curriculum Vitae

What do the Board Members do for the OBMI?

The Board members spend considerable time deliberating issues including policy, rule and procedure, reading materials pertaining to complicated technical investigatory cases and attending Board meetings.

Are there required credentials for the 12 member OBMI Board?

The 12 Board members are comprised of four physicians, five Oregon Medical Imaging licensees (one from each imaging modality) and three public members. All Board members are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate.

How do I apply to be an OBMI Board Member?

How often does the Board meet?

The Board meets four times a year for a Quarterly Board meeting.

Prior to the Quarterly Meetings, the Committee meets to discuss many Board issues including all of the Investigative cases. The Committee is a designated group of 4 Board members that rotate biennially. The Committee makes recommendations to the Full Board concerning the topics discussed at the Committee meetings.

How long is the term for a member?

Each Board member serves 1- three year term and is eligible for reappointment.
