

ATTENTION OBMI STAKEHOLDERS

Pursuant to HB 2011 Enrolled (2019), all persons practicing in the medical field are required to complete ONE hour of cultural competency continuing education upon renewal of licensure.

All renewals applied for on or after December 1, 2021 will need to include 1- hour of Cultural Competency CE.

On the OBMI website an APPROVED CE Cultural Competency course link is available for Renewal Applicants to satisfy this requirement. www.oregon.gov/OBMI

ALTERNATIVELY: Employers may Provide Employees with a certificate as follows for Reporting Cultural Competency Continuing Education as required by the OBMI:

Continuing Education Certificate Options:

- A.** Employer or Employer designee must create the certificate to satisfy OAR 337-030-0085(2) which is mandated for all licensees and permit holders at time of renewal. **The certificate would not apply or be used for ARRT CE credit.** The certificate would only be used by the licensee/permit holder for renewing their OBMI license or permit.

OBMI-Only Recognized Certificate requirements:

The licensee will need to submit a PDF formatted certificate containing ALL the following:

1. Name of Licensee
2. OBMI number of the licensee
3. Date of the Training
4. Name of the training activity
5. Number of hours to complete the training. (Minimum required: 1.0 hours)
6. Clearly stated on the certificate: "This training meets the cultural competency training as defined in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 337-010-0085(2)"
7. Signature of person-in-charge of the training activity
8. Clearly stated on the certificate in all capital letters: "THIS CERTIFICATE IS VALID FOR SUBMISSION TO THE OBMI ONLY".

- B.** Submit a CE sponsor request form, to the OBMI, for ARRT recognized CE credit. (The Board has a specific reference numbering system recognized by the ARRT as an SLA.) If Employer submits to request ARRT recognized credit, the requirements listed in the CE provider application must be followed. [Continued Education Approval Request Form](#)
