
RECENT BOARD PERMANENT RULES



AVOID A MISTAKE THAT MAY CAUSE A BOARD ACTION AGAINST YOU

The Board has been seeing an increase in licensees that have allowed their licenses to expire and then continue to practice on that expired license. Not only is this behavior a serious violation that can lead to a Board action and civil penalty, but Board actions are reported by statute to your credentialing organization and to the National Practitioner Data Base. Also, the Board may initiate a disciplinary case against your employer for allowing you to practice on an expired license. Here are some things you can do to avoid these expensive and serious violations of OBMI rules and statutes.

You can very easily avoid this mistake by getting your renewal done online!

As you know, your license is due for a renewal every 2 years on your birth month. Put a reminder in your phone or calendar to remind you to renew online the month PRIOR to the month you were born. This way, you will never be late!

Another way to avoid this mistake is to NOT practice at all until you have your renewal in hand or have verified that your renewal is approved by the Board and valid.
