Board Information / Responsibilities:

There are seven members on the Board; five licensed Naturopathic Physicians and two public members. The Board meets bi-monthly, the second Monday of all even months.

Member responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Review administrative investigations to determine if a licensee committed a violation of an Oregon Administrative Rule ([OAR](#)) or Oregon Revised Statute ([ORS](#)).
- Advise Board staff on best practices, and communicate with the public and licensees on issues related to the practice of Naturopathic Medicine.
- Engage in administrative rule making and propose legislative concepts to carry out the mission of the Board.
