RULE SUMMARY: The rule implements SB 1552 (2024) section 44 allowing a person to petition a licensing board for a determination as to whether a criminal conviction would prevent the person from receiving a license. Section 44 and the rule become operative on July 1, 2025. FILING CAPTION: Creates criminal conviction determination process to implement SB 1552 (2024)
