**CONSENT ORDER AND
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

1.

The Board of Naturopathic Medicine (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining naturopathic physicians in the State of Oregon, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) chapter 685 and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 850. Dr. Katyna TruVal, ND (Licensee) is a licensed naturopathic physician in Oregon and subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

2.

The parties wish to resolve this matter informally, without any hearing, appeal or judicial review, by entering this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order, pursuant to ORS 183.417(3) on the terms set forth below. The Board finds, the Licensee stipulates to, the Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action dated January 6, 2025, and incorporated herein.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Board finds, and the Licensee stipulates to the findings of facts and conclusions of law regarding the violations referenced in the Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action and this

Settlement Agreement and Consent Order. Licensee agrees that the Board may enter the Consent Order set forth below, including the following terms and conditions:

- A. Civil penalty: \$15,000. The Board will suspend \$7,500 of the fine, which will be discharged upon the successful completion of the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Consent Order. The remaining \$7,500 paid by Licensee on or before 60 days after entry of the Settlement Agreement and Consent Order.
- B. Probation: Three (3) years, with the following conditions:
 - a. Continued Education: Eight (8) hours of continuing education focused on ethical prescribing of controlled substances in addition to hours required for annual renewal per OAR Section 40. Licensee must submit outline of continuing education courses for Board approval within 15 days of signing this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order. The required approved education must be completed within the first six (6) months of probation.
 - b. Quarterly review of PDMP prescribing records.
- C. Licensee shall comply with the statutes, rules and orders of the Board.
- D. Licensee's failure to comply with any term of this order, ORS Chapter 685 or OAR Chapter 850, shall be grounds for additional discipline by the Board.
- E. Licensee enters into this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order voluntarily and without any force or duress. Licensee states the Board and Board's staff have not made promises or representations not stated herein to induce her to sign this document and agree to issuance of the Order.
- F. Licensee acknowledges that she had the opportunity to seek the advice of legal counsel. Licensee further acknowledges that she understands and agrees to the terms of this Order.
- G. Licensee understands she has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (ORS Chapter 183) and fully and finally waives all right

to a hearing and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order.

H. The parties acknowledge that this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order is a public document.

I. This Settlement Agreement and Consent Order shall take effect on the date it is signed by the Board.

The Board issues the following order:
