CONSENT ORDER

The Board of Naturopathic Medicine (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining naturopathic physicians in the State of Oregon. Nathan Daniel McVeigh, N.D., (Licensee) is a licensed naturopathic physician in Oregon, and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

The Board issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action to Licensee on or about November 16, 2016. Licensee was provided the opportunity to request a hearing on the Notice. In lieu thereof, the parties wish to resolve this matter informally, without any hearing, appeal or judicial review, by entering this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order, pursuant to ORS 183.417(3) on the terms set forth below.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. The Board and Licensee stipulate to the following:
 - a. Licensee's preparation and maintenance of inaccurate and incomplete patient charts, and failure to establish charts for patients, violated ORS 685.110(8), (14), and OAR 850-050-00190(3).
 - b. Licensee's failure to provide referrals for patients upon termination of care violated OAR 850-50-0190(10) and ORS 685.11(14).
 - c. Licensee's failure to report arrests and convictions of misdemeanors violated OAR 850-050-0120(5).
 - d. Licensee's concealment and denial of his arrests and convictions in an attempt to renew licensure constituted deception in order to secure a license, and violated ORS 685.100(1).

- e. Licensee's failure to respond to investigation requests and failure to advise the Board where he kept his patient records violated ORS 685.110(21).
 - f. Licensee's failure to report his professional and/or residential location and address changes to the Board violated ORD 685.110(16) and OAR 850-050-0130.
2. Licensee agrees the Board may enter the Consent Order set forth below.
 3. Licensee enters into this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order voluntarily and without any force or duress. Licensee states that the Board and Board staff have not made promises or representations not stated herein to induce him to sign this document and agree to issuance of the Order.
 4. Licensee acknowledges that he has had the opportunity to seek the advice of legal counsel. Licensee further acknowledges that he understands and agrees to the terms of this Order.
 5. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (ORS Chapter 183), and fully and finally waives any and all right to a hearing and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order.
 6. The parties acknowledge that this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order is a public document.
 7. This Settlement Agreement and Consent Order shall take effect on the date it is signed by the Board.

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CONSENT ORDER

The Board issues the following final order:

1. Licensee shall pay civil penalties in the total amount of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).
The Board suspends payment of the entire \$40,000 of these civil penalties, provided Licensee agrees to and abides by the following conditions:
 - a. Licensee will comply with the terms of this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order, ORS Chapter 685 and the administrative rules adopted by the Board in OAR Chapter 850. If Licensee fails to fails to comply with this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order, the Board may assess all or a portion of the suspended penalties.
 - b. Licensee agrees that he will not engage in the practice of Naturopathic Medicine in the future.
 - c. Licensee agrees that he will not apply for licensure in the state of Oregon.
2. Licensee shall comply with the statutes, rules and orders of the Board.
3. Licensee's failure to comply with any term of this order, ORS chapter 685 or OAR chapter 850 shall be grounds for additional discipline by the Board.
