CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to prescription drugs; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Not later than January 1, 2018, the Oregon Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing, the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine and the Oregon Board of Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners regulated by each board who are authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe opioids or opiates of the Oregon Opioid Prescribing Guidelines: Recommendations for the Safe Use of Opioid Medications, as endorsed by the Oregon Medical Board in January 2017.

SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the establishment of guidelines or recommendations as described in this section, the Oregon Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of Nursing, the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine and the Oregon Board of Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners regulated by each board who are authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe opioids or opiates of any guidelines or recommendations established by any association of practitioners whose members are regulated by the boards.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
