Requirements to upgrade pharmaceutical certification from Diagnostic (D) to Nontopical (T):

- Take and pass an approved 100 hour TPA course. Submit a certificate of attendance -or- take and pass the NBEO TMOD exam.

Requirements to upgrade pharmaceutical certification from Nontopical (T) to Nontopical TPA (AT):

- Take and pass the 2002 or later TMOD section of the NBEO examination -or- take and pass a 23-hour didactic NTPA course which is approved by the Board. Please submit documentation verifying one of these two requirements.
- If current CPR card is not on file with the Board, submit a copy of an American Heart Association's BLS Healthcare Providers level CPR certification or its equivalent per OAR 852-080-0040. If you haven't submitted a cognitive or skills based CPR course in the past to the Oregon Board of Optometry, an online course will not meet this requirement.

Requirements to upgrade from Nontopical TPA (AT) to Nontopical TPA with injections (ATI):

- Take and pass a Nontopical TPA workshop of at least seven hours or had equivalent training acceptable to the Board. Please submit documentation verifying this requirement.
- If current CPR card is not on file with the Board, submit a copy of an American Heart Association's BLS Healthcare Providers level CPR certification or its equivalent per OAR 852-080-0040. If you haven't submitted a cognitive or skills based CPR course in the past to the Oregon Board of Optometry, an online course will not meet this requirement.
