



# Oregon State Situation Report

2024 HPAI OUTBREAK

Current as of February 24, 2025

Since January 27, 2025, there have been 5 **additional positive premises in Oregon.**

## PREMISES QUARANTINES

Confirmed positive **poultry** premises are quarantined for a minimum of 120 days on average, although shorter quarantines may be utilized depending on the Cleaning and Disinfection (C&D) methods applicable to the premises. **Positive feline premises are not quarantined if the animal is deceased before testing was completed.**

## ACTIVE REGIONAL QUARANTINES (CONTROL ZONES)

Established for World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) designated poultry premises. Regional quarantines extend a minimum 10 km around an infected premises with movement restrictions on poultry and poultry products. Regional quarantines involve permitted movements and active surveillance for the designated area.

## Situation Summary (New information is in red)





# Map 1
