Oregon Department of Agriculture, Food Safety Program Bakeries: Laws and Regulations

A bakery is defined as any place, premises, or establishment where any bakery product is regularly prepared, processed, or manufactured for sale other than for consumption at the place where originally prepared.

Bakery products include

- Bread
- Rolls
- Cakes
- Pies
- Doughnuts
- Cookies
- Biscuits
- Crackers
- All similar goods to be used for human food

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 625 covers Bakeries and Bakery Products

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 603 Division 21 covers bakeries

<u>Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 616</u> covers Food and Other Commodities: Purity, Sanitation, Grades, Standards, Labels, Weights and Measures

<u>Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 603 Division 25</u> covers food establishment standards and standards for retail food service activities

The ODA retail food code is part of (OAR) 603 Division 25 and is used to regulate retail bakeries

The Code of Federal Regulations, 21 CFR Part 117, is used to regulate wholesale bakeries
