Oregon Department of Agriculture, Food Safety Program Refrigerated Lockers: Laws and Regulations

A refrigerated locker plant is any place offering separate and individual compartments for frozen food storage and preservation of food for human consumption. A refrigerated locker license is required if lockers are offered to the public for rent or other compensation.

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 628 covers Refrigerated Locker Plants

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 603, Division 17 covers Refrigerated Lockers

<u>Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 603 Division 25</u> covers Food Establishment Standards and Standards for Retail Food Service Activities. The General Standards section, 603-025-0020, is used for refrigerated locker facilities

The <u>ODA retail food code</u> is part of OAR 603 Division 25 and is used to regulate retail grocery stores, retail meat and bakeries as well as refrigerated locker facilities
