

## Wolf Management Zones in Oregon


— Wolf Management Zone Boundary




Minimum Count by Year




# Wolf-Livestock Conflict

The majority of ODFW's wolf management efforts are focused on reducing and responding to conflict








# Livestock Injured or Killed 2009-2024


