Introduction



2023 - HB 2001 passed



Financial assistance for ag worker housing



\$5 million available thru end of biennium



Expenses not allowed











Housing for workers under H-2A or any other temp employment

visa program

Construction of new housing

Routine operation or maintenance

Purchase of land or existing properties Costs before October 1, 2024



Funding

Only one grant per site address

Max. amount: \$200,000 or the est. budget, whichever is less

Graduated and additive scale:

Baseline of \$10,000

\$2,000/occupant for first 1 to 5

\$1,000/occupant for 6th to 10th

\$500/occupant for 11th and up



Some math...

• Five occupants

Baseline	\$10,000
1-5 occupants (\$2,000)	\$10,000
Total	\$20,000

Fifteen occupants

Baseline	\$10,000
1-5 occupants (\$2,000)	\$10,000
6-10 occupants (\$1,000)	\$5,000
11-15 occupants (\$500)	\$2,500
Total	\$27,500

Copy of ag housing registration with OR-OSHA



Documentation of costs for requested items



Property Owner Authorization form if the property owner is different than the applicant

Funds: 75% when signed, 25% after final report



Grants don't ensure OSHA compliance



Funds must be spent by Jan. 1, 2026
