PARC Case Discussion

PARC Case #25-0069 - 11 dead geese were found at Baskett Slough near Rickreall. Analytical results indicate the presence of zinc phosphide in the geese.

PARC #25-0070- ~130 dead cackling geese found at Staats Lake. Estimated to be deceased ~2-3 days before collection on October 14th based on reports from homeowners around the lake. All birds collected to seem to be at the same stage of decomposition. Only a few living cacklers left, one euthanized due to suspicious lethargy (delayed reactivity, laying on bank of lake). The others did not appear to present any concerning symptoms. Analytical results indicate the presence of zinc phosphide in the geese.
