2027 Renewals and 2026-27 Pesticide Product Registrations

September 15, 2026

You are receiving this notice because your company (or a company you represent) has pesticide products registered in the State of Oregon. Current-year registrations will expire on December 31, 2026, and registration renewal notices for 2027 will be mailed to you in mid-November. We are contacting you to provide you with a timeline for Oregon pesticide registrations for 2026 and 2027.

Registration Fee

The non-refundable fee for 2027 is \$400. This fee applies to all FIFRA Section 3 registrations, Section 24(c) "Special Local Need" registrations, and Section 25(b) "Minimum Risk Pesticide" registrations.

Timeline for 2026-2027 Current Pesticide Product Registration (PPR) License Holders

- **From the date of this letter until October 11, 2026**, you may submit any of the following through MyLicense (mylicense.oda.state.or.us):
 - New product applications for 2026 registration,
 - Revised labels,
 - Supplemental labels, and
 - Section 2(ee) bulletins/recommendations.
- **MyLicense will be offline from 12:00 AM on October 12 through November 13, 2026.**
 - You may NOT submit any revised product labels, supplemental labels, or Section 2(ee) bulletins/recommendations, either through MyLicense or through mail or fax. Please plan accordingly to submit any remaining new 2026 product applications, revised labels, supplemental labels or Section 2(ee) bulletins/recommendations for 2026 before the end of the day on October 11, 2026.
 - You may submit new product applications via paper application only. Our PPR application form is available at <https://oda.direct/HowtoRegister>.
- **November 16, 2026:**

- MyLicense will reopen for 2027 renewals and new product applications for 2027 registration.
- MyLicense will reopen for submission of revised product labels, supplemental labels and Section 2(ee) bulletins/recommendations.
- **December 31, 2026:** Current-year pesticide product registrations expire. After this date, if ODA has not received your 2027 renewal, your registrations are no longer active.
- **March 31, 2027:** MyLicense will close for 2027 renewals. If you need to renew a PPR after this date, contact an ODA Pesticide Registration Specialist.

Notice

Still need a new registration for 2026 after October 11?

We understand there may be situations where you need to submit a new product application for 2026 after MyLicense closes. We hope this advance notice will limit these situations. We can still accept late 2026 submissions after October 11, but you must apply using our paper application form. Please notify an ODA Pesticide Registration Specialist if you intend to submit a paper application after October 11. Use the application form available on at <https://oda.direct/HowToRegister>.

New Registrations for 2027

For current license holders, paper applications are not accepted for early 2027 registrations (i.e., before MyLicense reopens on November 16). Submit new product applications for 2027 registration through MyLicense with your renewal, or after your license has been renewed.

New Companies (No Current Registrations/No Active License)

A paper application must be submitted for the initial registration and may be submitted at any time. The application form is available at <https://oda.direct/HowToRegister>.

Expiring FIFRA Section 24(c) Special Local Need (SLN) Registrations

If your company or a company you represent has an SLN registration expiring on December 31, 2026, you will be contacted via email by Allie Tissot with renewal instructions. Unless instructed otherwise, do not submit any revised SLN labels or new SLN applications through MyLicense.

Reminders about submission of revised product labels, supplemental labels, and 2(ee) bulletins/recommendations:

- ODA will not process revised labels, supplemental labels, and 2(ee) bulletins submitted on paper. These must be uploaded to MyLicense during the appropriate time period.



- ODA does not accept routine submission of revised labels, supplemental labels, and 2(ee) bulletins by email. These must be uploaded online via MyLicense.
- TIP: Submitting many revised labels, supplemental labels, or 2(ee) bulletins in your annual renewal application will increase the time required for ODA to process your renewal application. We encourage you to submit these before our offline period begins (October 12), or after your 2027 renewal has been processed.

Renewal Notices for 2027 Registrations

As in years past, the ODA Licensing Office will be mailing official registration renewal notices in mid-November. The renewal notice is a postcard that lists your PPR license number and provides the web address to MyLicense.
