## Proposal for Substantial Change for two, existing Confined Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) in Area 1

### WHAT IS PROPOSED?

The Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) is proposing to approve a substantial change to an existing Medium CAFO NPDES Permit Registration for Wilsonview Dairy Inc, a dairy facility operated by Derrick Josi. Mr. Josi is requesting to combine the CAFO registration of an existing Medium CAFO (MA# 1000029) located at 130 Donaldson Rd, Tillamook, Oregon 97141 with an existing Medium CAFO (MA#63526), located at 2470 Olson Rd N, Tillamook, Oregon 97141. Both facilities are in Tillamook County. Combining these two operations and increasing the permitted animal numbers will change the size designation to a Large, Tier I CAFO. Both existing CAFOs are registered to the NPDES General Permit 01-2016, that was administratively extended on February 28, 2021.

The CAFO National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit 01-2016 regulates the manure, litter, and process wastewater generated by CAFOs to ensure that CAFO activities do not harm water quality.
