The Paired Comparison Process

The paired comparison process allows you to prioritize - even when everything is a priority!

Instructions:

- 1. List the tasks you need to do in any time-frame, in any order.
- 2. Then compare two-at-a-time as follows: A-B, A-C, A-D, A-E
- 3. Then compare B-C, B-D, B-E. Then, C-D, C-E,
- 4. And, finally, D-E.

With each comparison you ask yourself, "If I could only do one of these tasks, which one would I do?" Place a check-mark in the check column, then compare the next and check, etc. The item with the most checks is ranked your #1 priority. The second most checks, 2nd and so on.
