Lot Information: A lot is any group of plants designated for shipment. Preferably, a lot will be made up of a single cultivar/variety that has been grown in the same location. Lots can be made up of different cultivars if necessary. The size of the lot will determine the number of samples collected (see table below). Any positive detection within a lot will result in refusal of certification for the entire lot. Lot information can also be sent in spreadsheet form. Destination: Lots should be clearly identified for shipment to Georgia, Michigan, or Washington.

Additional Information:

- Sampling will occur between June and August.
- Sample size will be determined by lot size; samples will be pooled for testing.
- All plants must have had appropriate aphid control for at least 12 months prior to shipment. Spray records must be available for inspection and verification.
- The program is operated on a cost-recovery basis per OAR 603-052-1245. Fees will be invoiced upon the conclusion of testing.
- Testing results will be available in late August/early September.
