

## Case Criteria for pesticide-related incidents

Centralize receiving of information relating to **actual or alleged health** and environmental incidents involving pesticides. In most cases, if a pesticide was used and there are actual or alleged adverse human, animal, and/or environmental adverse effects, PARC will define as an incident.

### Human

- Pesticide poisoning was either diagnosed or suspected by a licensed health care provider OR
- An individual(s) reported symptoms they believe to be associated with pesticide exposure.

### Animal

- Pesticide poisoning was either diagnosed or suspected by a licensed animal health care provider OR
- Pesticide poisoning was either diagnosed or suspected by a licensed veterinary diagnostic laboratory OR
- An individual(s) reported observed symptoms in an animal that they believe to be associated with pesticide exposure.

### Environmental

- A pesticide is spilled OR
- A fire involving a pesticide(s) OR
- Documented evidence of environmental impacts from pesticide use by a PARC member agency.
