RULE SUMMARY

Currently, the annual registration fee is \$320.00. The rule increases the annual nonrefundable registration fee for each pesticide and each formula or formulation to \$360.00. House Bill 3549 (2015) increased the statutory maximum for pesticide registration fees to \$400. However, the Department of Agriculture has determined that at this time the fees need to be only be increased to \$360. This rule also makes the fee nonrefundable.
