

## Commodity Movement Guidance

INEDIBLE EGG PRODUCT (INEP) FROM PREMISES WITHOUT POULTRY

## **Product Description**


Inedible egg product (INEP) is dried, frozen, or liquid egg products that are unfit for human consumption.

## Requirements to be Met Prior to Movement

- ☐ Traceability information (premises identification number [PIN], GPS coordinates, or other) is available.
- ☐ The premises of origin (stand-alone processing plant) biosecurity measures are acceptable to State and Federal Regulatory Officials.
- ☐ The epidemiological assessment is complete (premises of origin) and indicates no dangerous contacts with Infected Premises.
- ☐ Truck & driver biosecurity is implemented as described in the appropriate Secure Poultry Supply (SPS)
  Permit Guidance document (see sub-bullet)
  - Movement of INEP from premises without poultry to pasteurization or landfill (negligible risk)

## **Commodity Requirements Flowchart**

Inedible Egg Product (INEP) from a Premises without Poultry



Inedible egg product (INEP) may move by permit from premises without poultry to pasteurization or landfill, provided permit requirements have been met. Requirements include appropriate traceability information, acceptable biosecurity, and a complete epidemiological assessment.
