



# Commodity Movement Guidance

## NEST RUN SHELL EGGS

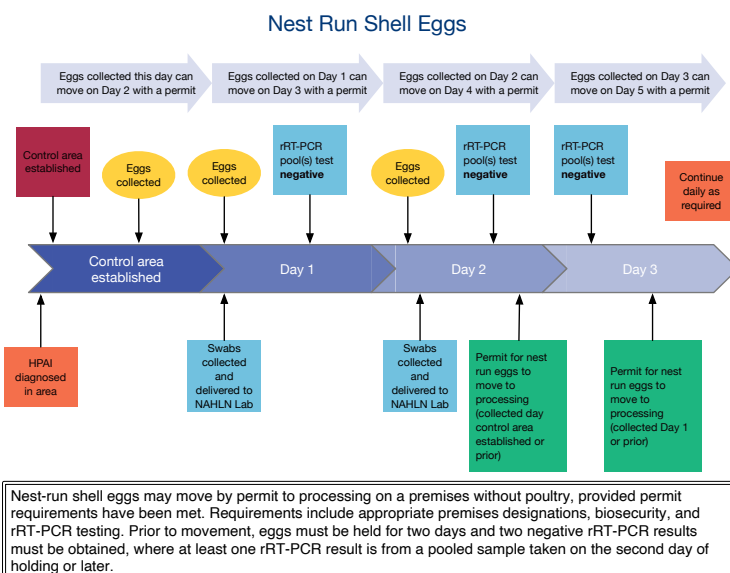
### Product Description

**Nest run shell eggs** are eggs that have been packed as they come from the production facilities without having been washed and sanitized.

### Requirements to be Met Prior to Movement

- ❑ Nest run shell eggs are moving from a premises that meets the criteria for a Monitored Premises designation (not an Infected Premises, Contact Premises, or Suspect Premises) and has a national premises identification number (PIN).
- ❑ Truck & driver biosecurity is implemented.
- ❑ Product-specific biosecurity as described in the appropriate Secure Poultry Supply (SPS) Permit Guidance document (see sub-bullet) is implemented and acceptable to Responsible Regulatory Officials.
  - [Movement of nest run shell eggs<sup>1</sup>](#) (low risk)
- ❑ Two negative real-time reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction (rRT-PCR) results and a two-day hold, where at least one rRT-PCR is from a pooled sample on the second day of holding or later.
