A Licensed Domestic Kitchen or Exempt Cottage Food Establishment may use a physical street address instead of a UIN. The UIN is an option provided in OAR 603-025-0325(e).
The use of expired or unauthorized UIN is a violation of ORS 616.250(1).
Oregon's UIN was created by Oregon statute and might not be recognized by other states or federal agencies. Questions related to the regulations of other states should be directed to the respective state.
A UIN is personal to the applicant and cannot be transferred to another person or entity.
UIN registration is valid for a one-year term beginning July 1 and expiring on June 30 each year.
Registration fees are not pro-rated.
