### 4. Please be aware of the following:

- a. Filing of a notice of transfer of plat for shellfish cultivation must be accompanied by claim or plat certificate reissuance fee of \$100 per affected claim or plat. ORS 622.340(3).

<sup>1</sup> "Claimant" means "a person or agency that claims control of a plat granted by the department under ORS 622.210 to 622.992." OAR 603-082-0020(1).



- b. The transfer does not change any terms of the grant certificate, including any provisions for how aquaculture is to be conducted on the transferred plat(s).
- c. The new claimant must obtain the required licenses from the Oregon Department of Agriculture Food Safety Program before selling any farmed shellfish from the transferred plat(s).
- d. Cultivation fees are billed on a quarterly basis at the rate of \$3.50 per acre for Approved ground, and \$1.25 per acre for any portion of the plat which may fall within an area classified as Prohibited (if applicable). Once shellfish are commercially harvested, a use tax will apply at the rate of 10 cents per bushel, 10 cents per gallon, or 1 cent per dozen.
