Overview of Services

Air Tutors was the first to bring video conferencing to public school classrooms and created the nation's first online high-dosage tutoring program. Due to Air Tutors innovative model, in 2017 they began sharing strategies with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation and Air Tutors multiple scientific studies have all demonstrated statistically significant outcomes.

Driven by a mission to advance global learning, Air Tutors community of educators brings both expertise and passion to every class. More than 70% of tutors hold Master's or PhDs and the majority have over a decade of teaching experience and share the enthusiasm that makes learning engaging and enjoyable for students.

Air Tutors began by supporting English Learning students with bilingual tutors and have been effective with Special Education students. Their flexible programs run before, during, and after school hours which can all be tailored to meet district's specific needs.


Alignment to Oregon's Early Literacy Framework

Air Tutors' services align closely with Oregon's Early Literacy Framework by delivering evidence-based, high-dosage tutoring grounded in foundational literacy skills, including phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.

Tutors are trained to deliver explicit, systematic instruction aligned to HQIM and informed by ongoing formative assessment, progress monitoring, and diagnostic data.

Air Tutors' culturally responsive model prioritizes asset-based instruction, multilingual support, and tutor–student matching that reflects students' linguistic and cultural identities. Family engagement is embedded through regular communication, literacy strategy sharing, and home-based practice supports.

Air Tutors also builds educator capacity by providing actionable data insights, session summaries, and collaborative feedback loops that support teachers in reinforcing early literacy instruction across settings.



Evidence of Impact

Since 2020, Air Tutors has demonstrated consistent, statistically significant positive impacts on student achievement across multiple large-scale scientific evaluations.

Independent studies conducted by WestEd and Mathematica—funded by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, Accelerate, and Arnold Ventures—found meaningful gains in literacy and mathematics for participating students, particularly those furthest from opportunity. These evaluations include rigorous designs and confirm improvements in foundational skills, academic growth, and engagement.

District partners consistently report accelerated progress for early learners and increased instructional coherence between tutoring and classroom instruction, reinforcing the effectiveness and scalability of Air Tutors' high-dosage tutoring model.
