Overview of Services

K12 Tutoring provides live, synchronous online tutoring delivered by state-certified teachers. Students interact directly with their tutor on camera in real time.



Alignment to Oregon's Early Literacy Framework

K12 Tutoring delivers synchronous, virtual small-group instruction focused on building foundational literacy skills aligned with Oregon standards.

Certified teachers use learner background knowledge to develop individualized plans targeting reading comprehension, vocabulary, and writing, incorporating student needs. Learners begin with an age-appropriate assessments to help match them with the right tutor, with special considerations for Special Education and English Language Learners. Live sessions promote student belonging, oral language development, and confidence through peer interaction.

Progress is monitored through formative assessments and tracked against Oregon learning standards. Educators access student metrics via an integrated dashboard, with monthly reports from a dedicated support team. After each session, learner growth is reviewed to adjust goals and plans, ensuring continuous progress. Instruction is delivered consistently by certified teachers within a supportive, virtual environment tailored to each student's academic needs.



Evidence of Impact

During the 2023-2024 school year, over 800 students participated in math and ELL tutoring in grades 3-8. Non-tutored students saw a decrease in their scores on the Virginia SOL state math assessment from 2023 to 2024, whereas tutored students showed a significant increase indicating a shift in proficiency.

Notably, up to 29% of students who participated in ELA and math tutoring demonstrated significant academic growth, advancing from a "not proficient" status in 2023 to "proficient" in 2024, signifying their achievement of a passing score on the SOL.

Additionally, the data revealed a strong correlation between time spent in tutoring and improved performance, with each hour of math tutoring contributing to an increase of up to 4.8 points on SOL scores highlighting the effectiveness of tutors and their personalized academic support.

Furthermore, through partnership with Instructure, a third-party edtech research company, it was found that K12 Tutoring satisfies Level II requirements (Moderate Evidence) of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).
