

Littera Education's tutoring aligns with Oregon's Early Literacy Framework by strengthening foundational reading skills through evidence-based, Science-of-Reading-aligned instruction, including explicit phonics delivered via high-quality curricula.

Tutors are trained to provide individualized, culturally responsive support that fosters strong relationships and equitable access to literacy learning.

Littera's data-driven virtual classroom enables continuous assessment and real-time progress monitoring, while family engagement is supported through coordinated communication and scheduling.

Evidence of Impact

Littera Education's tutoring has demonstrated strong impacts on student achievement, with districts reporting significant gains in early literacy.
