## Overview of Services

The team is comprised of experienced PK–12 educators and leaders who work with individuals, teams, and school and district leaders to build educator capacity and ultimately student learning. Strategies are gradually released with ongoing capacity-building to ensure that the improvements made during partnership are sustained long after it ends. Above all, MGT aims to create learning environments where every child is seen, supported, and empowered to succeed.



## Alignment to Oregon's Early Literacy Framework

MGT's services align with Oregon's Early Literacy Framework through a comprehensive, equity-centered approach. Grounded in the Science of Reading, professional learning and coaching develop educator expertise in foundational skills, including phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.

Culturally responsive practices are embedded by honoring student identities and promoting inclusive, asset-based instruction that reflects diverse backgrounds. MGT supports the effective use of assessment by helping educators analyze data to inform instruction, track progress, and target supports. The work also emphasizes family engagement, equipping schools with tools and strategies to build strong partnerships with families that reinforce literacy at home.

Central to MGT's approach is building educator capacity through side-by-side coaching, job-embedded professional development, and collaborative planning. MGT strengthens individual practice and schoolwide systems to ensure sustainability and impact. Through this aligned and integrated model, MGT supports Oregon educators in fostering early literacy success for every child, in every classroom.
