

Alignment to Oregon's Early Literacy Framework

Building on deep educational expertise, Varsity Tutors has incorporated the ability to assess specific skills from the curriculum as they are taught. Each student's experience would be based on Oregon Academic Content standards and the Early Literacy Framework, ensuring that learners remain focused on the right content and that reporting is clear for teachers and administrators. Varsity Tutors proprietary assessments (aligned with Oregon standards) measure each student's progress, qualitatively and quantitatively, toward target grade-level proficiency.

Their versatile whiteboard adapts to a multitude of needs depending upon the student and subject. With emergent readers, tutors leverage Orton-Gillingham Reading Tiles and built-in practice questions, which include age-appropriate reading passages and comprehension questions. These resources help students build foundational reading skills like phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. Students learning to write use the document editing feature to engage in the writing process, including pre-writing, drafting, revising, editing, and publishing.
