

Alignment to Oregon's Early Literacy Framework



EdEx facilitates professional learning grounded in key models of reading development identified in Oregon's Early Literacy Framework. The training emphasizes the "big five" components of reading—concepts of print, phonological awareness, phonics, decoding skills, fluency, and word recognition—drawing on the work of Anita Archer. Sessions also explore the relationship between decoding and language comprehension, underscoring the importance of integrating both for effective literacy instruction.

In addition to decoding, the professional learning highlights the integration of writing into reading instruction. By incorporating research-based practices that connect reading and writing, educators gain strategies to help students express understanding through written language while reinforcing reading comprehension. This comprehensive approach ensures educators are equipped to support early literacy development with a balanced focus on both reading and writing.
