After discovering structured literacy approaches, she served seven years as a Reading Specialist before pursuing doctoral studies. At the University of Oregon, she refined her expertise in explicit instruction, structured literacy methods, and adult learning, earning her Ph.D. in Special Education in 2016. Currently, Dr. Fritz serves as an Associate Professor at Eastern Oregon University and is the Founder and Executive Director of the EOU Reading Clinic, which trains teachers and provides tutoring services to children in rural Oregon.


Pricing

Alignment to Oregon's Early Literacy Framework

Ronda Fritz Consulting offers services closely aligned with the Oregon Literacy Framework, providing instruction in scientifically validated literacy practices outlined in the framework. Training is grounded in the principles of the Simple View of Reading and Scarborough's Reading Rope, emphasizing the range of competencies children need to become proficient readers.

The consulting approach includes guidance on using assessment effectively to tailor instruction to individual student needs and maximize outcomes. The goal is to equip educators with evidence-based practices and systems that promote literacy success for all students, including culturally and linguistically diverse populations.



Evidence of Impact

The training provided by Ronda Fritz Consulting has given educators the tools and skills to effectively implement structured literacy methods, which has made tangible gains in literacy growth. In one year of training, one district improved across all grade level bands (K-6; see attached PP Slideshow). A second district took a similar approach to comprehensive professional development and saw gains across all grade levels as well (see attached PP slides-District #2). After one session on explicit instruction, one administrator in District #2 said, "I have been in education a long time and this is, by far, the best professional development I have ever been involved in."
