



# What is the High-Dosage Tutoring Supplement?

In the 2025 legislative session, ODE received additional funds to support statewide early literacy high-dosage tutoring (HDT) efforts. This High-Dosage Tutoring Supplement distributes \$12 million grant-in-aid directly to prioritized districts to expand tutoring programs focused on improving early literacy outcomes for grades PreK-5\*.

## Allowable Use of Funds

Requirements Aligned to Early Literacy Success Grants	Expanded Grade Levels
➤ HDT programming must meet <u>High-Dosage Tutoring</u> Criteria.	PreK – 5 <sup>th</sup> Grade*
<ul> <li>Tutors must meet all <u>Qualified Tutor Criteria</u>.</li> <li>Contracted HDT providers must be from the <u>ODE-Approved Provider List</u>.</li> </ul>	

## **HDT Supplement Requirements**

#### **Prioritization**

Districts must prioritize HDT Supplement funds for high-need schools, based on 2024-2025 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade ELA proficiency and focal student groups served.

## **Supplement, Not Supplant**

HDT activities funded through the HDT Supplement funds must be used to **expand or establish** tutoring activities. By accepting these funds, districts assure that HDT activities do not replace ELSSDG funds already allocated to HDT.
