




What is the High-Dosage Tutoring Supplement?

In the 2025 legislative session, ODE received additional funds to support statewide early literacy high-dosage tutoring (HDT) efforts. This High-Dosage Tutoring Supplement distributes \$12 million grant-in-aid directly to prioritized districts to expand tutoring programs focused on improving early literacy outcomes for grades PreK-5*.

Allowable Use of Funds

HDT Supplement Requirements

Prioritization

Districts must prioritize HDT Supplement funds for high-need schools, based on 2024-2025 3rd-5th grade ELA proficiency and focal student groups served.

Supplement, Not Supplant

HDT activities funded through the HDT Supplement funds must be used to **expand or establish** tutoring activities. By accepting these funds, districts assure that HDT activities do not replace ELSSDG funds already allocated to HDT.
