

Federal School Improvement (CSI/TSI) 2026-27 School-level Improvement Plans

Rationale

This document provides guidance to complete the **2026-27 School-level Improvement Plan** for districts with schools identified for Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) or Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) through the Federal School Improvement (FSI) process.

Completing the 2026-27 School-level Improvement Plan

In order to align with expectations from the US Department of Education, ODE requires the following for school-level improvement plans:


1. Community Engagement and Needs Assessment

- a. No action is needed; this is embedded in the 2025-27 Integrated Application.

2. School-Level Improvement Strategies

- a. Process:
 - i. Quarter 1 Reporting (Oct. 1-Nov. 15, 2026): Districts and schools will collaborate to identify which outcomes and strategies from the District Integrated Plan schools will be focusing on.
 - ii. Use the 2025-27 Outcomes and Strategies link in the [Integrated Programs Reporting and Application WorkApp](#).
 - iii. In the “CSI/TSI Identified School(s)” column, ensure that the correct schools are listed next to their improvement strategies. Remove any schools that have been exited and add any newly identified schools, matching them with the correct Strategy. *See screenshot below for an example.*
 - iv. If a new strategy is needed to meet the needs of identified focal groups or outcomes, a Plan Change process will be required. Please see the Plan Change Requests tab of your [Integrated Programs WorkApp](#) for additional information about how to request a plan change.

Note for Districts with Allocations: FSI funds will be available beginning July 1, 2026. Expenditure reporting will be completed at the district level with Integrated Reporting.
