#### **EIIS Community of Practice**

This community of practice will include eight monthly 90-minute synchronous, virtual meetings over the course of a school year. Facilitators will coach teams through the planning and implementation of their action plans and introduce key concepts, goals and outcomes, and tools and resources. This session will run from **August 2024 to May 2025** with 8 virtual collaborative learning sessions.

Between meetings, teams will have the opportunity to use the tools to advance their continuous improvement cycle. This learning series will help participants:

- Use data to develop and implement an action plan to improve their EIIS systems and achieve more equitable outcomes for all students
- · Identify and share problems of practice that present challenges to improving EIIS systems
- Collaborate on effective strategies to address shared problems of practice
